# NIOBRARA VALLEY HOSPITAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE POLICY SUMMARY

It is the policy of Niobrara Valley Hospital (the "Hospital") to provide financial assistance to qualifying patients with their outstanding bills for medically necessary and emergency care provided at the Hospital. It is also the policy of the Hospital that an FAP — eligible individual can't be charged more than the amounts generally billed for emergency or other medically necessary care.

## PATEINTS THAT QUALIFY FOR FINACIAL ASSITANCE

To receive financial assistance under the Financial Assistance Policy (the "Policy"), you must be financially indigent.

#### **Financially Indigent**

To be "Financially indigent", you must be uninsured or underinsured and have a household income equal to or less than 100% of Federal Poverty Level ("FBL"). If you qualify as "financially indigent" financial assistance will be provided based on an all or nothing policy.

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

The Hospital encourages patients who may qualify to apply for financial assistance. Patients can apply for financial assistance by completing and submitting a financial assistance application to: Business Office, Niobrara Valley Hospital, PO Box 118, Lynch, NE 68746.
